The In-Country Manager will be the primary POC for USG and Prime Contractor personnel involved with the Afghan National Police Mentorship Program. The In-Country Manager shall base him/herself in the Kabul PMO and be available on a 24-7 time frame to manage all personnel and issues in Afghanistan occurring during the life of this contract. The In-Country Manager will maintain primary oversight on execution of the program and ensure all activities meet cost, schedule and performance requirements. In-Country Manager will oversee various reporting to the management team, as well as to the Prime contractor, and to various USG entities involved in the program. In-Country Manager will ensure all personnel are compliant with program metrics and regulations, and that personnel conform to the utmost ethical standards.
