**Duties and Responsibilities:** Supports the USG, Combined Security Transition Command – Afghanistan (CSTC-A) and NATO Training Mission – Afghanistan (NTMA), mission to develop and implement a mentoring, training, and operational support capability for the Counter Narcotics Police – Afghanistan. Training for members of the Afghanistan CNP-A, to include specialized investigative and operational units of the CNP-A. Training for foreign counterparts on a wide variety of drug law enforcement investigative and analytical subjects, including the use of firearms, operational planning and tactics. Training for members of other law enforcement and/or security units of the Government of Afghanistan

**Required Qualifications:** Must have significant experience in isolated regions or hostile environments. Must maintain current documented skill certifications in Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS), International Trauma Life Support (ITLS) and U.S. National Paramedic Registry. Must be able to work with minimal direction, to multi-task, meet deadlines, and set priorities in keeping with CNP-A Program standards and expectations. Must have and demonstrate a strong proficiency in MS Office and Acrobat. Effective oral and written communication skills with all levels of the organization. Strong organizational skills with the ability to manage time and multiple priorities to completion. Must be in excellent health and be able to deploy globally to include hostile environments (Afghanistan). Work environment varies from an office setting to austere conditions. The work schedule is a 60-hour work week; however, in some high-tempo periods, extended hours may be required

**Desired Qualifications:** Medics who have graduated from the U.S. Army 18D Combat Medical Sergeant School and/or USN Independent Duty Corpsman who have operational experience as combat Medics preferred. Potential employee with Combat experience in Operation Enduring Freedom(OEF) / Operation Iraqi Freedom (OIF) desired.
